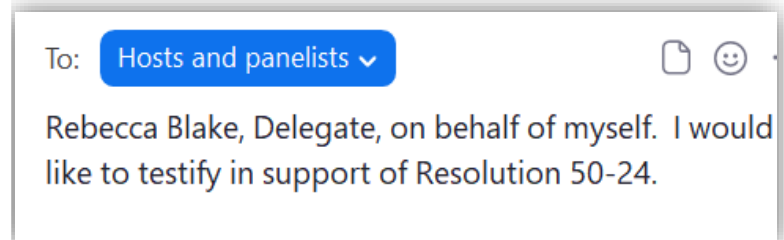
Entering the Meeting

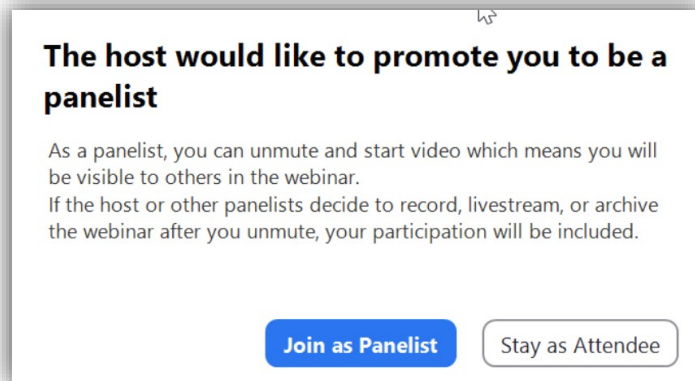
To Notify Your Intent to Testify

- In the chat box, write that you would like to provide testimony. Provide your name, which resolution, if you support or oppose and if you are testifying on behalf of yourself or your delegation.



When It's Your Turn to Testify

- When it's close to your turn, the moderator will call your name and you will be asked to be promoted from attendee to panelist.
- Click Join as Panelist. This will allow you to speak and have your camera on. Wait to be called on.



After You Testify

- You will be returned to attendee status.
- Repeat the process if you would like to testify again.
