

Clarification for Blue Cross Complete providers: Entering BMI in Michigan registry is encouraged, but not required

Blue Cross Complete encourages providers to enter BMI into the Michigan Care Improvement Registry. It is **not** a requirement, as was indicated in the November - December issue of *BCN Provider News*. Providers are required to report immunizations of children, birth through 19 years of age to MCIR within 72 hours of administration. In addition, BCBSM also highly recommends reporting adult immunizations to MCIR since it is a lifespan registry.
