Michigan Licensing and Regulatory Affairs Requirements

Medical License and Regulatory Affairs Requirements for Medical Doctors

Each medical doctor is required to complete 150 hours of continuing education in courses or programs approved by the board of which a minimum 75 hours of the required 150 hours must be earned in courses or programs designated as Category 1 programs.

Medical License and Regulatory Affairs Requirements for Osteopathic Physicians

Each osteopathic physician is required to complete 150 hours of continuing education in which a minimum of 60 continuing education credits must be obtained through Michigan LARA category 1 programs and a minimum of 40 hours of continuing education must be AOA approved.

Other license requirements for both medical doctors and osteopathic physicians include:

- Pain and Symptom Management - Three hours of continuing education every three-year relicensure cycle. At least one of the three hours must include controlled substances prescribing.
- Medical Ethics - One hour of continuing education every three-year relicensure cycle.
- Implicit Bias – Three hours of continuing education every three-year relicensure cycle.

An applicant for new licensure, both limited and medical, shall have completed a minimum of 2 hours of implicit bias training within the 5 years immediately preceding issuance of the license or registration.

Other license requirements for both medical doctors and osteopathic physicians include:

- **Human Trafficking** - one-time training that must meet objectives outlined by LARA.
- **Opioids and Other Controlled Substances Awareness Training Standards for Prescribers and Dispensers of Controlled Substances** - This is a one-time training that must meet objectives outlined by LARA and is separate from continuing education for an individual seeking a controlled substance license or who is licensed to prescribe or dispense controlled substances. Licensees that prescribe or dispense controlled substances who renewed in 2019 must complete training by January 2023, renewals for 2020 by 2024, renewals for 2021 by 2025.
- **DEA MATE ACT** - Effective June 27th, 2023, the U.S. Department of Justice Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) requires all DEA-registered practitioners to complete a one-time, 8-hour training requirement "on the treatment and management of patients with opioid or other substance use disorders."

Past training can count towards a practitioner meeting this requirement if it was accredited with AMA PRA Category 1 Credit(s)[™] and covered required content. Exemptions include physicians that are board certified in addiction medicine or addiction psychiatry or graduated from a medical, dental, physician assistant, or advanced practice nursing school within five years of June 27, 2023.

The deadline for satisfying this new training requirement is the date of the prescriber's next scheduled DEA registration submission, regardless of whether it is an initial registration or a renewal registration, on or after June 27, 2023.
