Credentialing Process

As early as 7:00 am, delegates may begin logging into the meeting. When joining, please be sure your screen name includes both your first and last name. Delegates will need to turn their cameras on long enough to be credentialed by staff as they are moved from the waiting room to the zoom room. If a physician is not on the official Roster of Delegates as a delegate in the [handbook](#), they will not be allowed to enter the meeting.

Alternate to Delegate

Alternates may replace delegates if an open slot remains. The delegate must not already be in the session and the alternate must be on the official Roster of Delegates in the handbook. Testifying

Only delegates in the zoom meeting will be able to provide testimony. The process is very similar to the Reference Committees. Delegates wishing to speak should write their name and resolution number in the chat box. When called on, unmute and begin speaking.

Voting

Voting will take place using the poll feature in zoom. Results will be shared on the screen. Delegates will practice voting prior to the resolution reports.

Second Session

A second session of the House of Delegates has been called for the changes to the bylaws associated with the Reorganization Report. This session will immediately follow the closing of the first. Delegates should remain in the zoom meeting for the second session.
