**Whereas, some pharmacies are open 24-hours a day/seven days a week, and**

**Whereas, the inability of the patient to obtain a prescribed medication in a timely manner can put a patient at risk for serious consequences; therefore be it**

**RESOLVED: That MSMS work with the appropriate pharmaceutical association to establish a basic formulary that should be available in all pharmacies to allow patients easier and appropriate access to prescribed medications especially those designated as 24-hour or extended hour pharmacies.**
