Whereas, the state of Michigan has 20,000 doses of rabies vaccine in storage with no way to distribute it, and

Whereas, access to the vaccine in many counties can only be obtained by going to the emergency department, and

Whereas, this can easily cost patients in excess of \$4,000 for the five-dose rabies vaccination series; therefore be it

RESOLVED: That MSMS work with the Michigan Department of Community Health to develop alternative delivery sites for injections two through five of the rabies vaccine in coordination with the Health Department.
