Whereas, the AMA supports the development of medical education curricula on disaster medicine, and the medical response to terrorism (D-130.992), and

Whereas, the Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC), in cooperation with the Centers for Disease Control and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, has developed guidelines for teaching disaster and bioterrorism education to medical students, according to “Training Future Physicians About Weapons of Mass Destruction: Report of the Expert Panel on Bioterrorism Education for Medical Students;” therefore be it

RESOLVED: That MSMS support guidelines of the Association of American Medical Colleges regarding “Training Future Physicians about Weapons of Mass Destruction: Report of the Expert Panel on Bioterrorism Education for Medical Students;” and be it further

RESOLVED: That MSMS encourage all Michigan medical schools to incorporate disaster and bioterrorism education into their four-year medical school curriculum.
