Title: Legalization of Marijuana for Medical Use

Whereas, the question of legalizing marijuana for medical use will be on the ballot in November, 2008; therefore be it

RESOLVED: That MSMS support the use of cannabinoids by routes other than smoking for medical uses, for which scientific evidence supports efficacy equal or superior to established therapies; and be it further

RESOLVED: That MSMS encourage further research to elucidate the efficacy of cannabinoids in various medical conditions and its optimal dosage and route of delivery; and be it further

RESOLVED: That MSMS support of the use of cannabinoids by routes other than smoking for medical uses does not constitute support of the ballot initiative.
