**Whereas, lack of access to a vehicle can have a deleterious effect on the quality of life of senior citizens, and**

**Whereas, many Michigan communities, including Traverse City, through its Traverse Livable Community project are already tackling this problem; therefore be it**

**RESOLVED: That MSMS support the appropriate agencies, including the Michigan Office of Services to the Aging and the 16 Area Agencies on Aging, to help improve access to transportation for Michigan seniors, and to promote related resources to its membership.**
