16 **Whereas, MSMS has adopted the precautionary principal, and**

18 **Whereas, Bisphenol A (BPA) is a suspected carcinogen and a known**  
19 **hormone destructor and disease-causing agent at very low levels, and**

20  
21 **Whereas, BPA has been shown to interfere with chemotherapy in breast**  
22 **cancer patients, and**

23  
24 **Whereas, there are alternatives to BPA, and**

25  
26 **Whereas, the AMA has not yet taken a position opposing the use of BPA**  
27 **or in support of the precautionary principal; therefore be it**

29 **RESOLVED: That MSMS encourage hospitals and physicians offices to**  
30 **forgo the use of products containing Bisphenol A; and be it further**

31  
32 **RESOLVED: That MSMS recommend to patients to whom they provide**  
33 **care to avoid the use of products containing Bisphenol A; and be it further**

34  
35 **RESOLVED: That MSMS encourage local, state, and national retailers to**  
36 **avoid making available products that contain Bisphenol A.**
