16 **Whereas, there is an increasing number of invasive office procedures, and**

18 **Whereas, many of these procedures are done under limited sedation, and**

20 **Whereas, invasive procedures by their nature involve the risk of untoward**
21 **and unpredictable complication and even death, and**

23 **Whereas, there is no supervisory body or oversight program to ensure**
24 **competency or outcome of these procedures; therefore be it**

25
26 **RESOLVED: That MSMS institute proceedings to form a regulatory body,**
27 **be it governmental, private, insurance-based, or combinations thereof, to require,**
28 **inspect, and review office invasive procedures and sedation for the welfare of the**
29 **patients involved with requirements to ensure adequate training of the providers**
30 **to include updated knowledge of CPR, adequate equipment on the premises**
31 **such as monitors and defibrillators, and transparency of review of such**
32 **procedures.**
