14 **Whereas, motor vehicle injuries, some of which are fatal, are a significant**
15 **public health issue, and**

17 **Whereas, accurate data is necessary to understand the cause of the**
18 **injuries, and**

20 **Whereas, less than 10 percent of motor vehicle safety-related complaints**
21 **are reported to the government (*Detroit Free Press*, Feb 7, 2010, page 6A), and**

23 **Whereas, the Food and Drug Administration has a model to have all drugs**
24 **and device safety issues reported to the government directly or indirectly via the**
25 **manufacturers on a simple easily available form (Form 3500), and**

27 **Whereas, the Food and Drug Administration model has been effective in**
28 **identifying safety-related problems of drugs and devices; therefore be it**
29

30 **RESOLVED: That MSMS support a reporting mechanism for motor vehicle**
31 **safety-related issues similar to Food and Drug Administration Form 3500; and be**
32 **it further**

34 **RESOLVED: That the Michigan Delegation to the AMA ask the AMA to**
35 **support a reporting mechanism for motor vehicle safety-related issues similar to**
36 **Food and Drug Administration Form 3500; and be it further**

38 **RESOLVED: That the Michigan Delegation to the AMA ask the AMA to seek**
39 **rules similar to the Food and Drug Administration rule that would have the**
40 **National Highway Traffic Safety Administration or the Department of**
41 **Transportation develop a form similar to the Food and Drug Administration Form**
42 **3500 for reporting motor vehicle safety defects; and be it further**

44 **RESOLVED: That the Michigan Delegation to the AMA ask the AMA to seek**
45 **rules from the Department of Transportation and/or National Highway Traffic**
46 **Safety Administration that would require motor vehicle manufactures and/or their**
47 **suppliers to report all safety related complaints.**
