Whereas, options other than traditional residency training do exist, and

Whereas, in the case of The American Board of Radiology there is recognition of alternative pathways to prepare physicians for Board eligibility, and

Whereas, The American Board of Radiology recognizes physicians who have preformed residency programs and have become Board Certified in their country of origin, and

Whereas, The American Board of Radiology gives Board eligibility after completion of four years of fellowship training or junior faculty positions in a hospital with a recognized residency program; therefore be it

RESOLVED: That MSMS request the AMA to pursue similar alternative pathways for other specialties as a way of alleviating the projected physician shortage and to help communities retain physicians.
