Whereas, for a hospital to demand that a physician on staff who is over 70 years old take a physical or neuropsychological exam constitutes age discrimination and violates his or her civil rights and should not be enforced; therefore be it

RESOLVED: That MSMS challenge hospital medical staff policy that mandates all physicians of a particular age undergo physical and neuropsychological exams in order to remain on staff; and be it further

RESOLVED: That MSMS encourage hospital administrations to institute a policy by which a physician who demonstrates signs of impairment be referred to an independent physician committee that would refer the physician for a physical and/or neuropsychological exam as dictated by pre-determined criteria and a majority vote of the committee.
