Title: Registry for Medical Marijuana

House Action: Adopted as Amended.

Whereas, Michigan Automated Prescription System (MAPS) is a prescription monitoring program for the State of Michigan, and

Whereas, MAPS is used to identify and prevent drug diversion at the prescribers, pharmacy and patient levels by collecting schedule 2-5 controlled substance prescription dispensed by pharmacies and practitioners, and

Whereas, collection of this prescription information allows physicians, dentists, pharmacists, NP, PA, Podiatrist and veterinarians to query this data for patient- specific reports which allows a review of the patient’s schedules 2-5 controlled substance prescriptions records, and

Whereas, access to this data enables practitioners to determine if patients are receiving controlled substances from other providers and to assist in the prevention of prescription drug abuse, and

Whereas, Michigan Medical Marijuana Program (MMMP) is a state registry program within the Bureau of Health Professions at the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, and

Whereas, medical marijuana is class 1 schedule of controlled substance and not part of MAPS reporting, and

Whereas, the MMMP maintains a registry list, and

Whereas, the MMMP registry is a confidential list of “qualified patients” and “approved caregivers” to which the department has issued registry identification card, and

Whereas, currently the disclosure is only to (a) authorized employee of the department to perform official duties of the department (b) authorized employees of state of local law enforcement agencies, only as recovery to verify that a person is a lawful possessor of a registry identification card; therefore be it
