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14 Whereas, pharmacies and other entities are performing more immunizations on
15 patients than ever before, and
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17 Whereas, it is of critical importance that physicians have access to information
18 regarding what tests or immunizations are being performed on or provided to their
19 patients, respectively, and the results of such tests, and
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21 Whereas, consistent with the goals of patient-centered medical homes,
22 physicians need pharmacies and other entities to provide clinical updates to a
23 patient's primary care physician as appropriate, and
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25 Whereas, it is of critical importance that pharmacies¹ and other entities
26 determine a patients' primary care physician of record when performing tests or giving
27 immunizations; therefore be it
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29 RESOLVED: That MSMS support the requirement that pharmacies and other
30 entities providing immunizations to patients, report such action, and enter all
31 immunizations administered to patients into the Michigan Care Improvement Registry
32 and, if feasible, to the patient's primary care physician either electronically or via fax,
33 and be it further
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35 RESOLVED: That MSMS pursue regulatory or legislative action that requires
36 pharmacies and other entities providing immunizations to all patients to report such
37 action into the Michigan Care Improvement Registry.
