Whereas, water test turnaround time and transparency of reporting in the Flint water crisis has been a major impediment to avoid lead exposure for infants, children, and adults, and

Whereas, shortening the time lag between testing of water and reporting of results is critically important for the purpose of primary prevention, and

Whereas, the results of water tests are critical to avoiding morbidity and mortality related to toxic water exposure; therefore be it

RESOLVED: That MSMS supports the adoption of regulations to require the public reporting and electronic availability of all water tests for impurities and heavy metals by city, county, state, and federal units of government no later than seven business days from the date that the water sample was taken.
