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Title: Participation in PDMPs by Federally-Funded Health Facilities

Whereas, state-sponsored prescription drug monitoring programs (PDMPs) have been expanded throughout the country to help identify fraud and abuse related to controlled substances, and

Whereas, federally-funded health facilities and the Veteran’s Administration dispense scheduled medications, but are not required to report to state-sponsored PDMPs; therefore be it

RESOLVED: That MSMS ask the Michigan Boards of Medicine, Osteopathic Medicine and Surgery, and Pharmacy to encourage federally-funded health facilities including the Veteran’s Administration to participate in the Michigan Automated Prescription Programs (MAPS), and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Michigan Delegation to the American Medical Association (AMA) ask our AMA to encourage the federal government to require all federally-funded health facilities including the Veteran’s Administration to participate in state-sponsored prescription drug monitoring programs that fit their geographic location.
