Whereas, the new prescribing rules created to help resolve the opioid crisis have complicated the prescribing of non-opioid scheduled medications, and

Whereas, the current scheduling system does not differentiate between scheduled opioids and non-opioids, and

Whereas, opioids could be differentiated from non-opioids by dividing each Food and Drug Administration schedule class into two classes, for example, 3-O for opioids and 3-N for non-opioids; therefore be it

RESOLVED: That MSMS supports updating the scheduled medication classification to differentiate between opioids and non-opioids; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Michigan Delegation to the American Medical Association (AMA) ask our AMA to advocate with the United States Drug Enforcement Agency to seek changes in the scheduled medication classification to differentiate opioids from non-opioids.
